

Mosquito Research Foundation, an Overview. To promote and provide financial aid to mosquito and vector control related scientific research that supports and furthers the objectives of public health and the control of mosquitos and vectors is the mission of the MRF. The Foundation was originated in California under the University of Ca. Davis, to benefit the Mosquito Control Districts in Ca. When UC Davis redirected the funding, the Foundation, which was funded mostly by mosquito control districts, decided to expand the Foundation across the Country. This year 53 proposals were accepted for review and requested funding is over 2.5 million dollars. Unfortunately, only approximately 200K is available. Researchers in Utah, Florida, California and USDA (Florida) awarded last cycle, 2013-2014.
