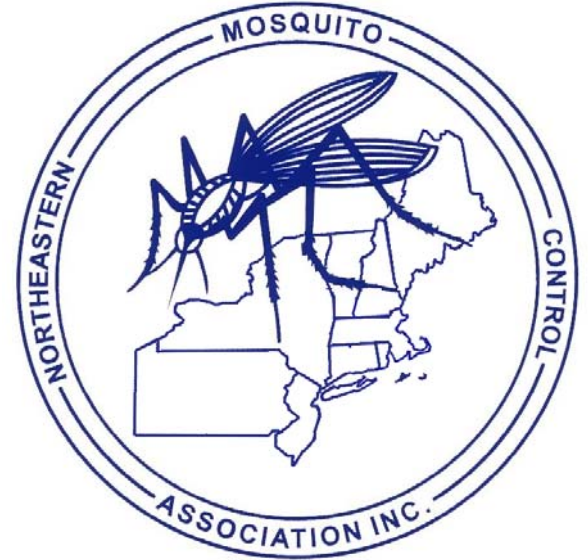

NMCA GRANT & SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

NMCA accepts scholarship and grant requests each year, and awards up to \$2,000 in each category.

THE JOBBINS SCHOLARSHIP

The Jobbins Scholarship will go to a student whose work is in an area relevant to mosquito, biting fly control or other vectors in the Northeast related to disease transmission; for example, wetlands biology-ecology, entomology or vector parasitology. Studies may range in nature from purely ecological to strictly vector control.

THE McCOLGAN GRANT-IN-AID

The McColgan Grant-in-Aid will go to an individual whose work is directly related to the advancement of operational mosquito control: for example, surveillance technology, spray technology, biological control, physical control, data processing.
